Managed by Tourism Australia's dedicated business events unit, Business Events Australia, the program will fund projects that have the potential to influence domestic decision makers or convert new domestic business events. Destination North Coast will be submitting an application however we would encourage destinations and venues to consider this opportunity in your own right as well.
