Executive PA Roadshow - 8 September 2020

Results from this event were encouraging, producing leads valued at more than \$700K from a total of 13 clients, which ranged in size from executive level retreats for 10-12, through workshop and leadership conferences for 20 – 50 delegates up to conferences for 160 delegates.

Buyers were primarily interested in venues within driving distance of Brisbane CBD which resulted in the overwhelming majority of leads being for the Byron – Tweed areas.

The event was held at The Emporium Hotel South Bank on 8th September but due to Covid-19 border closures we were unable to attend in person. As such, our involvement was limited to a "Zoom" presence for the Pre-Scheduled Appointment (PSA) program which consisted of 12×15 minute meetings with business event buyers.

We shared a presentation with buyers offering a summary explanation of the Destination North Coast Business Events program and focussed primarily on prospecting for new business.

Feedback from buyers reflect a strong desire to return to normal conferencing cycles. BE budgets have not been used and the restrictions have created pent up demand.

As consumer confidence returns, we are looking forward to locking these leads in for you, our partners. Thank you for your continued support.

The Events Uncovered show was held at Sydney Masonic Centre on Thursday 17 September 2020 and was the first face to face tradeshow event we have attended since COVID-19 restrictions have eased.

This show was a hybrid event for attendees with DNC having access to the 70 delegates who attended in person on the day.

Delegates were given the opportunity to learn about exhibitors and their offerings during catering breaks; on arrival, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. We supplied a door prize (regional produce filled within our branded esky) valued at \$120 to encourage people to visit the DNC stand.

All in all, despite some minor hiccups, Destination North Coast would look at attending this event again when it is presented in its traditional format.

Major Announcement - Restarting Australia's Business Events Sector

On 11 September 2020 the Australian Government announced it would provide \$50 million to create the Business Events Grants program. This assistance is part of the \$1 billion Relief and Recovery Fund which is providing assistance to sectors, regions and communities disproportionately affected by the economic impacts of COVID-19. The program will be administered through the Australian Government's Business Grants Hub, with guidelines developed in consultation with the government and industry stakeholders.

This initiative will support business events by providing grants to meet up to 50 per cent of costs incurred in participating at a pre-approved business to business event in Australia

during 2021. It will empower not only the business events sector, where the required cancellation of events due to COVID-19 has seen a near 100 per cent loss of revenue, but also the broader business community by stimulating high value, multi-day business to business events across multiple sectors of the economy.

The initiative will instil confidence back into the business events sector as Government backing will help ease concerns about financial loss and encourage businesses to return to business events, when it is safe to do so.

Eligible Applicants

The upfront grant (\$10,000-\$250,000) will meet up to 50 per cent of costs incurred in participating at a pre-approved business to business event, such as space hire, design and manufacture, plus travel and accommodation.

Support would target larger, multi-day business to business events that promote Australian Government's industry priorities and sectors. The schedule of pre-approved events (and associated costs eligible for funding) will be developed by Austrade in consultation with other Commonwealth, State and Territory Government partners and the business events sector.

Should an event be cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions, then the non-refundable amount (as identified in the program guidelines) will be entirely met by the Australian Government.

Timing and Administration

Funding will support approved business to business events in 2021. Once a schedule of approved events has been developed, applicants will be encouraged to apply via the Business Grants Hub through a submission and assessment process.
