The ongoing challenges that our industry has faced inevitably create heightened levels of stress, anxiety and concern for operators and stakeholders. It is essential that you take care of yourself as well as your organisation throughout these times. NSW COVID Support

Find information about the current <u>COVID-19 Support Package</u> including a handy <u>summary of current</u> <u>support packages for individuals and business</u> now available online. The NSW Government will also cover the <u>disaster recovery payments</u> for areas outside the Commonwealth declared hotspot from week four of the NSW lockdown providing valuable support across the state.

The NSW Government offers a free **Business Concierge** who can help you with information on grants among other things.

We encourage you to also keep an eye on the **Service NSW website** for more information as it's released - including detailed eligibility criteria.

Please make sure you are taking care of yourself, and those around you, and if you need support for your mental wellbeing during this difficult time, here are some **useful links** for where you can reach out and get assistance or talk to someone.

Accelerated 2021 COVID-19 Business Support Grant Now Open

Eligible NSW businesses, sole traders and not-for-profit organisations can apply for up to \$15,000 from the first of the NSW Government's economic support packages: The 2021 COVID-19 Business Support Grant mentioned above.

The **2021 COVID-19 Business Support Grant** is available to NSW businesses that have a turnover of more than \$75,000 and up to \$50 million, and have a total annual wages bill of below \$10 million. Businesses can expect to start receiving funds from the Business Support Grant from the end of July.

Eligible businesses for the 2021 COVID-19 Business Support Grant will receive:

- \$15,000 for a decline in turnover of 70 per cent, or more
- \$10,500 for a decline in turnover of 50 per cent, or more
- \$7,500 for a decline in turnover of 30 per cent, or more.

Eligible businesses with a turnover from \$75,000 and up to \$50 million, which maintain their staff headcount will receive tax-free fortnightly payments of 40 per cent of their weekly payroll, with a minimum payment of \$1,500 per week, and a maximum payment of \$10,000 per week. Eligible non-employing businesses will receive \$1,000 per week. These payments will also be made fortnightly.

Applications for the second tranche of assistance, which includes the <u>Micro Business Support Grants and</u> <u>the JobSaver program</u>, is also open. Read <u>Media Release</u>.

Support for individuals impacted by the current COVID-19 restrictions and stay-at-home orders is available through **Services Australia**.

National Cabinet Meeting

The recent **National Cabinet meeting** endeavoured to map a pathway forward and discussed Australia's COVID-19 Vaccine Strategy, additional measures introduced by the NSW Government to stop the spread of the Delta variant, as well as the lockdowns in Victoria and South Australia. National Cabinet has agreed to a suppression strategy for COVID-19 with the goal of no community transmission. Australia's COVID-19 vaccine roll out continues to expand, with almost 11 million doses of the vaccine administered in Australia to date.

Business Connect is a dedicated and personalised NSW Government program that provides trusted advice to help small businesses start, run, adapt or grow. The program can help business owners recover from disruption by offering confidential, independent business advice, as well as events and online resources to develop your business skills. Business advisors can help businesses to develop a recovery strategy, manage change, manage cashflow, access finance, market a business and connect to other government support. Business Connect support is available free of charge for small businesses who have been impacted by COVID-19 restrictions.

South-East Queensland Set To Host The 2032 Olympics And Paralympic Games

South-East Queensland will be hosting the **2032 Olympics and Paralympic Games**, which is incredible news for Queensland and Australia more broadly and also presents as an amazing opportunity for the North Coast and our visitor economy. With the firsthand knowledge that Australia's hosting of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games was the most significant event in the history of inbound tourism, accelerating the development of Australian tourism by at least a decade, the 2032 Olympics has the potential to deliver significant economic benefits, potentially generating up to \$36 billion for Queensland as the host state and creating 130,000 direct jobs, in addition to the tens of thousands indirect jobs.

Council Rates Relief For Bushfire Victims Extended For Another Six Months

The NSW Government is continuing to support victims of the devastating 2019-20 bushfires, announcing \$2.5 million to fund another six months of council rate relief for those who lost their main properties.

The council rate relief package has been extended for people whose main property was significantly damaged or destroyed by bushfires, if it has not yet been rebuilt or changed ownership.

Federal Government Boosts Australia's Indigenous Tourism Sector

The first round of recipients for the Australian Government's Indigenous tourism grants, as part of the \$40 million Indigenous Tourism Fund were announced this week. The Morrison Government has committed more than \$2.9 million to support 60 Indigenous-owned tourism businesses and community organisations. This funding will increase the number of Indigenous tourism products available and support the start-up, stabilisation and growth of operators in the sector.

North Coast Mud Trail 2021!

The **North Coast Mud Trail** will be held 10 am - 4 pm, 14th & 15th August 2021. The much-loved pottery event has seventeen professional ceramic artists' studios to visit. Over the two days, visitors can meet with the artists, attend workshops, and buy locally made pottery pieces.

All studios have COVID safety measures in place, including the Service NSW app for check-in. Prebooking may be required and visitors are asked to wear a mask, check-in with the Service NSW app and social distance.

Bottlebutt Bash Trail Run
