Recovery for Regional Tourism Grant - Business Events Project

As part of the \$1.25M awarded to Destination North Coast through the Federal Government's <u>Recovery for Regional Tourism Program</u> the Business Events Project was designed to support growth and development of North Coast tourism businesses with the aim of increasing jobs and driving interstate visitation to the region.

The combined activity included

- 1. **Business Event Roadshows** to Sydney and Brisbane
- 2. **Business Event Familiarisations** in Coffs Harbour and Port Macquarie
- 3. **Reboot Incentive Fund** providing financial support to secure eight new Business Events for the north coast.

The combined activity generated the following results:

- 1,704 total visitors
- 3,919 visitor nights
- \$1,328,364 estimated economic impact

Additionally, 21 live leads were generated through this activity with the potential to generate the following impacts:

- 3,236 visitors
- 7,442 nights
- \$2,649,352 potential estimated economic impact
