BUSINESS EVENTS BITES #44 December 2022 - January 2023

As expected, leisure business has been strong across the North Coast over the peak holiday season. The weather was great, borders were open and business events partners were busy taking care of holiday makers for what has been a successful summer period.

Business Events also continued to deliver in December and January, with the conversion of three leads representing 640 delegate nights and \$227,840 and another five new leads being generated that represent 1,914 delegate nights and \$681,384 in potential economic impact for the North Coast.

Your DNC team visited business events partners in the southern half of the region during the week of the 23rd of January and it was inspiring to receive updates from operators.

AIME and the *Destination NSW Feel New Northern Rivers Post AIME Famil* are only a week away and your BE team is working through the final preparation stages for these two valuable initiatives.

NSW Regional Business Event Development Fund

The NSW Regional Business Event Development Fund is designed to help stakeholders create, attract and support exciting business events for regional NSW and to support new business event initiatives.

The Fund aims to enrich these business events with opportunities offered by iconic towns and regions, while helping secure successful conferences and events for their future.

Managed by Destination NSW, the Fund is designed to assist stakeholders create, attract and deliver new business events and business event-related infrastructure projects in regional NSW.

Grant funding (from a pool of \$750,000 excluding GST) will be available as per individual event or business event project guidelines below:

- Up to \$15,000 (ex GST) for a business event with up to 150 delegates (projected attendance)
- Up to \$30,000 (ex GST) for a business event with over 150 delegates (projected attendance)
- Up to \$50,000 (ex GST) for a business event infrastructure project where the venue can accommodate up to 250 delegates
- Up to \$100,000 (ex GST) for a business event infrastructure project where the venue can accommodate more than 250 delegates

This fund was launched by the Minister for Tourism, the Hon. Ben Franklin MLC in Kingscliff in the Tweed demonstrating the growing reputation of the North Coast as a leading Business Events destination. Applications are open from Monday 13th February through to 31st March 2023.
