

# BUSINESS EVENTS BITES #46 March 2023

March has seen the DNC Business Events team busy with the follow-up from both AIME and the Event Organiser's Summit.

On 17 March, your DNC Business Events team visited the Coffs Harbour region and met with business event partners. It was an excellent opportunity to introduce Kerry our new Mid North Coast, Business Events representative, and discuss and update on current and future business events. The team held an equally successful series of meetings in Port Macquarie and other Mid North Coast destinations during the first week of April.

On 23 March, your DNC Business Events team attended the first Event Organiser's Summit for the year in Brisbane. The positive meetings generated six leads with a potential economic impact of \$255,078 for the North Coast.

March saw the conversion of 2 leads representing 1,110 delegate nights and \$377,910 in estimated economic impact to the overnight visitor economy of the North Coast.

It was a busy end to the month, with the team supporting the finalisation and submission of 15 Regional Business Events Development Fund applications for the North Coast region.

#### **\$2 Million For Business Event Data**

The Federal Government has confirmed a \$2 million allocation to measure the impact and benefit of business events. The Government will work closely with the Business Events Council of Australia to roll out "bespoke data collection points including venues, organisers, delegates and exhibitors" across the country.

Tourism Minister, Don Farrell, noted that business events are vital drivers of the wider economy and contribute around \$36 billion annually in industry expenditure. "They encourage high-yield travel, build networks, support the development of commercial concepts and expand business opportunities," he said. "The new business events data project is a critical part of the Government's support for the ongoing recovery of Australia's business events sector. "Better data means better decisions, better decisions mean better events, and better events mean a bigger boost for Australia's visitor economy."

Leo Jago, Chair of the Business Events Council of Australia, said the \$2m allocation is the country's largest ever single investment in business events research, and will help establish a long-term framework to measure the sector's contribution. He urged industry to provide data in a timely fashion.

### **New Tourism Minister Announced**

Premier Chris Minns has announced his government's first full ministry, with The Honourable John Graham MLC sworn in by Governor Margaret Beazley AC KC as NSW Minister for Jobs and Tourism.

Mr Graham will also be Minister for Roads, Minister for the Arts and Minister for Music and the Nighttime Economy.
