

# BUSINESS EVENTS BITES #51 August 2023

August was a busy month for trade activity for the DNC business events team who attended Events Uncovered and the Event Organisers Summit in Sydney and the Corporate Travel Show in Canberra.

The busy month of activity paid off with the conversion of 6 existing leads representing 1,940 delegate nights and \$1,048K in projected impact to the overnight visitor economy. Direct sales activity also generated 4 new leads with a potential impact to the overnight visitor economy of \$646K for the North Coast.

The Business Events team visited business event partners across the whole of the North Coast and ran the Business Events: Best Practices session in Yamba.

The event generated 2 new leads with a potential impact to the overnight visitor economy of \$250K for the North Coast.

### Event Organisers Summit - Sydney 15 August 2023

Event Organisers Summit was the inaugural event at the Western Sydney Convention Centre at Penrith on the 15th of August.

The format of this event combines keynote presentations with 12 table top meetings. The attendees were from a wide selection of industries and the event generated 3 new leads with a potential economic impact of \$245K for the North Coast.

The keynotes included Solar Buddy who conducted an abridged version of their *Hour of Power* team building activity designed for businesses and event organiser to educate their teams on energy poverty. The program connects participants to communities via a hands-on solar light building activity.

# **Tourism Research Australia to Report Business Events Data**

Australia's long-term strategy for the visitor economy, <u>THRIVE 2030</u>, notes that having relevant, robust and timely data is critical for growth. It underpins good decision-making, business growth and investor confidence.

In the October 2022 Budget, the Australian Government announced \$2 million in funding for Tourism Research Australia (TRA) to include business events measurements in national and international datasets. TRA will engage with ABEA to source data from venues, organisers, delegates and exhibitors and your DNC business events team will disseminate relevant information as it becomes available
