This ensures that you will receive a 100 per cent authentic cultural experience whilst also enjoying adventure.

Wajaana Yaam Gumbaynggirr Adventure Tours are important for the local Gumbaynggirr community. Tourism provides the opportunity to ensure the continuation of the transfer of intergenerational cultural knowledge whilst also providing employment.

Furthermore, a proportion of the profits will be invested in Bularri Muurlay Nyanggan Aboriginal Corporation (BMNAC). BMNAC delivers weekly after school learning centres (90 annually), cultural camps and extensive Gumbaynggirr language revitalisation initiatives.

Forest Sky Pier

A 10-minute drive from Coffs Harbour up through banana plantations, Forest Sky Pier at Niigi Niigi - Sealy Lookout, sits within a flora reserve in Orara East State Forest, part of the amazing State Forests of the Coffs Coast, on Gumbaynggirr country.

Forest Sky Pier offers magnificent coastal views over the city of Coffs Harbour and up and down the coastline. There are walking tracks through the rainforest, including the beautiful Gumgali Track which shares the Gumbaynggirr story of Gumgali the black gonna, in sculpture, art and sound.



Treetops Adventure

Experience the iconic Australian bush like never before. Get up-close and personal with native Australian wildlife and magnificent gumtrees, as you climb, weave and fly through the tree tops on self-guided high rope courses. Flex your adventurous spirit and test yourself mentally and physically with over 100 elevated obstacles with rope ladders, wobbly bridges, tunnels, cargo-nets and zip lines.

Yarrila Place

Nestled in the heart of the city is a contemporary cultural hub - the newly opened Yarrila Place. Named after a Gumbaynggirr word meaning "illuminate, brighten, light up or illustrate", this state-of-the-art building is home to the Yarrila Arts and Museum (YAM), a dynamic three-level library, City services and plentiful community and creative spaces.

Yarrila Place includes a number of bookable spaces for meetings and offsite events, including the impressive River Oak room and rooftop terrace catering for up to 250 people.


Woopi Brewing Co.

Woolgoolga Brewing Co. (or Woopi Brewing Co. to those in the know!) is an award-winning craft brewery venue that can cater for up to 200 people, located 20 minutes north of Coffs Harbour on the NSW North Coast.

The Taproom and Beer Garden offer a relaxed and informal space, with the ability to host live music, Brewery Games on the lawn and Brewery Tours. The whole venue can be set to cater for Corporate presentations and functions.

With more than 16 beers on tap, a selection of wines, small batch spirits and a fully functional Brewery kitchen - Woopi Brewery can create a memorable event that is just a little different.
