Business Events for Regional NSW

Business events were a stand-out sector for regional NSW in the year ending September 2023.

Domestic overnight conference visitors to NSW spent on average \$517 per night, which was 132.9 per cent higher than domestic leisure visitors spend (\$222 per night).

It was also significantly higher than the expenditure by domestic and international business visitors to Sydney.
