NSW Government Delivers Relief To Support Music Festivals

Minister for Music and the Night-Time Economy, John Graham recently announced new regulatory and financial support for music festivals struggling under the pressure of increasing costs. This comes after the NSW Government committed to review the Music Festivals Act. The review found the regulatory framework would benefit from a closer focus on harm reduction, industry sustainability, and ensuring costs for festivals in NSW are at a level comparable to other states, while still prioritising health and safety at festival events. As part of these reforms, music festivals across NSW will receive two years of emergency funding assistance, with an initial \$3 million allocated, and benefit from sector-wide reforms as they weather headwinds that have led to numerous cancelled events.

Northern Rivers Towns and Villages Resilient Business Activation Program

Northern Rivers Towns and Villages Resilient Business Activation Program

This **\$9.5** million grant program will support the economic recovery of villages and town centres in the Northern Rivers through direct assistance to small and medium sized businesses and local government-led Central Business Districts (CBD) activation and revitalisation projects.

It will be delivered across the seven most impacted Local Government Areas in the Northern Rivers region: Tweed, Ballina, Byron, Lismore, Kyogle, Richmond Valley and Clarence Valley. Funding is available through two targeted streams:

Stream 1 - Infrastructure support for small and medium sized businesses. Grant amounts - from **\$250,000 to \$2 million**

Stream 2 - CBD activation and revitalisation projects delivered by Councils. Grant amounts - from **\$50,000 to \$500,000**

Expression of interest applications are now open; EOI applications close on 4 October 2024.





DNC Are Looking For A Business Events, Business Development Executive

The DNC Business Events Program, Business Development Executive would manage the Mid North Coast region stretching from MidCoast to Coffs Harbour City Council areas and also incorporating Lord Howe Island. The role would bring a whole of destination approach with the primary aim of securing Business Events for the North Coast. In addition, they will support stakeholders to improve the bid success ratio, represent the region and deliver initiatives that will lead to upskilling of industry.

Working with professional conference organisers, corporate organisations, meeting planners and directly with business clients, they will assist in bidding for and securing these events.

The Business Development Executive will be employed on a contract based on 20 hours per week. Remuneration will be dependent on experience and relevant skills for the role.



Australia's Wine Tourism State

Tourism Research Australia data shows NSW is Australia's top destination for international visitors seeking wine tourism experiences. NSW welcomed 252,200 international winery visiting travellers, who stayed 9.1 million nights and spent \$1.3 billion during the year ending December 2023.



Recreation Spending Rises

The CommBank Household Spending Insights Index shows spending on recreation rose 0.7% in August 2024. The increase was driven by online travel bookings and airlines. This was partly offset by reduced spending on ticketing services, accommodation, cruise lines and travel agencies.
