Activity Summary July 2025

July was a strong month for business events activity across Destination North Coast, with continued high levels of client engagement and a clear focus on converting opportunities into confirmed bookings.

We secured one converted lead representing 600 delegate nights and an estimated \$234,000 in visitor spend. In addition, 11 new leads were generated—totaling 2,386 delegate nights and an estimated \$942,474 in visitor spend.

Despite this typically being a slower period for new business, interest remained strong. Attendance at the Executive PA Summit in Sydney was particularly successful, directly generating the 11 new leads now moving through our sales pipeline, supported by tailored proposals and proactive stakeholder engagement.


