Activity Summary August 2025

August was another strong month for business events activity across Destination North Coast, with high client engagement and a continued focus on converting opportunities into confirmed bookings.

We secured **two converted leads**, representing **1,000 delegate nights** and an estimated **\$405,600 in visitor spend**. In addition, **12 new leads** were generated - totaling **2,803 delegate nights** and an estimated **\$1,202,487 in visitor spend**.

This performance highlights sustained interest in the region, even during traditionally slower periods. Ongoing proactive engagement and tailored proposals are ensuring momentum in the sales pipeline and positioning the North Coast as a leading regional business events destination.

Increased Aviation Access to the North Coast

QantasLink is expanding its use of the modern A220-300 in Coffs Harbour, with a second route to see the new jet in the coming months. The regional jet will serve Coffs Harbour on Sydney services starting in late October, having launched on the Melbourne route in October last year. At the same time, QantasLink will also increase its Sydney-Coffs Harbour return flights from 24-26 per week.

This expansion is a major win for Coffs Harbour and the wider North Coast region. For the local economy, this means more opportunities for tourism, business events, and investment, supporting local businesses and event venues.

Destination NSW is proud to lead the delivery of this bold new roadmap for visitor economy growth through to 2035.

Following a comprehensive review and consultation with more than 500 NSW stakeholders, the NSW Visitor Economy Strategy 2035 will guide collaboration between government and industry over the next decade. It has a clear target of \$91 billion in annual visitor expenditure, 40,000 hotel rooms, 8.5 million new airline seats and an additional 150,000 jobs by 2035.

The strategy will unlock new growth opportunities across Sydney, Western Sydney and regional NSW.
